## Digi Communications N.V. reports accelerated revenue growth in the first quarter of 2022

## **Highlights**

- The dynamic in Q1 has been remarkable with a 21% increase in revenues YoY, from continued operations.
- Based on the solid operational results, Adjusted EBITDA (excluding IFRS 16 impact) reached €105
  million
- Growth trajectory continues for revenue-generating units (RGU), up 15.2% YoY.
- The revenues of the Spanish operations grew by 42.3% YoY.
- Sale of Hungarian operations was completed in January 2022.

Digi Communications N.V. exceeded its financial and operational performances in the first quarter, in comparison with the same period of the previous year. The Group's consolidated revenues from continued operations grew by 21% in Q1 of FY22 to € 361 million. Adjusted EBITDA (including IFRS 16) marked an increase of 9.5% year-on-year, up to € 124 million. Adjusted EBITDA (excluding IFRS 16) grew by 6.1% to € 105 million.

In January 2022, the Group successfully completed the transaction regarding the sale of its Hungarian operations for a total amount of € 625 million.

During the first three months of this year, DIGI increased its service portfolio by 2.5 million units, reaching 18.7 million RGUs, delivering rich and versatile services to its residential and business customers.

In its home market, DIGI can look back on a quarter of substantial growth in customer numbers. Romania reached 14.4 million RGUs, representing a growth rate of 9.5% YoY. The growth was supported by both mobile and fixed broadband services, which together contributed 79% of the total additions. In Romania, DIGI maintained its leadership among the telecom operators, in terms of mobile and fixed portability, adding more than 180.000 numbers in Q1 2022 and exceeding 3.4 million numbers ported since the launch of the portability service (October 2008).

The Spanish operations revenues reached € 111 million, representing 42% growth YoY, driven by 29% increase in mobile user numbers, as well as more than doubling the fixed broadband and telephony user base. Mobile users reached a total number of 3.2 million, while the broadband users attained 575 thousand.

**Serghei Bulgac, CEO of Digi Communications,** commented: "DIGI delivered another strong earnings performance in the first quarter of 2022. Following the successful sale of our Hungarian operations we concentrated our efforts on the legacy markets: Romania, Spain and Italy. We are also looking at opportunities beyond. We are grateful to our customers for their continued trust and we remain committed





to further offer outstanding services. I would also like express deep gratitude to our colleagues for delivering this superior achievement".
